

Pursuant to the provisions of Personnel Rule No. 19, you are hereby notified that you are suspended, without pay, for two hundred and forty (240) working hours for violations of Personnel Rules No. 21b1, 21b3, 21b16 and 21b17.

This is the result of an incident which occurred on or about April 2, 1993, at 1900 hours, while at 52 East Baseline. While off-duty at a Checker Auto store you agreed to a proposition, made by the store clerk, to allow you to remove merchandise without payment to Checker Auto, in exchange for cash payment to the clerk. The fraudulent transaction was completed with your complicity. As the result of the investigation you were found to be in violation of the following:

General Order No. B-2.1.C.(8) - Conduct unbecoming an employee; that which tends to bring discredit on the department.

General Order No. B-2.1.C.(6) - Employees will not relate a false, deceptive or misleading account of an incident or fact at issue in an investigation or other matter of concern to the department.

Your disciplinary and performance history was considered in determining the thirty day suspension.
