SUMMARY OF INVESTIGATION:

On December 25, 2010, Officer Roman Narbaez #8988 responded to a radio call of a burglary. Officer Narbaez obtained the information necessary to author a departmental report (D.R.) but secured at the end of his shift without doing so. Approximately five months later, Officer Narbaez received a missing D.R. notice. While being questioned about the status of the missing D.R., Officer Narbaez told his supervisor he contacted the victim who no longer desired prosecution, thereby eliminating the need to author a report. The victim denied this contact occurred and reaffirmed her desire for prosecution.

Officer Narbaez later told investigators of the Professional Standards Bureau (PSB) that he did not complete a D.R. on the date of the incident and that he was untruthful with his supervisor when he stated he had contact with the victim who no longer desired prosecution. The allegations that Officer Narbaez failed to complete a departmental report and provided an untruthful verbal report to his supervisor regarding the issue are sustained.
