SUMMARY OF INVESTIGATION:

On October 6, 2012, Officer Tylon Wilson II #8681 and Officer Steven VanGeertry #8635 responded to emergency radio traffic of a subject firing a gun at 7933 West Williams Street. Upon the officer's arrival, suspect Adrian Gonzalez Martinez was contacted and taken into custody. While effecting the arrest, Officer Wilson displayed unreasonable force by kicking Adrian Martinez in the face, failed to accurately report the use of force to the supervisor on scene, and failed to accurately document the use of force incident in his departmental report. The incident was later reported by Officer VanGeertry to his immediate supervisor, Sergeant Gina Stephenson #8385, while at Estrella Mountain Precinct after the incident had concluded.
